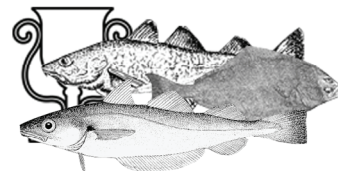

What's new this season?

It's the start of a new season and there are a few changes from the way things are done this season.



- Dabs and Flounders are sizeable 18cm and above
- White rag and silvers are allowed at club and open matches
- Introduction of a few pegged matches during our season.
- There will be a few matches this season outside our usual catchment area
- The club is also going to organise a few out of hour social matches for members and non members
- The points scoring system is one point for a blank, 20 points for a win 19 for second etc.
- At the end of the season 3 of your worst scores are dropped (includes matches you were unable to attend) to keep the competition alive till the end.
- This seasons accumulator matches will also change from previous years. From the summer accumulator you will drop your poorest 3 matches and 5 matches for the winter one. The scoring system has also changed, 20 points for a win, 19 for second etc. At the end of the accumulator the winner gets 60 points with a drop down in 2 points for the next place ad so on.
- We have also added trophies for 2nd, 3rd and 4th place for the overall points competition.

Promoter: Dean Conway Second by Robert Ford & Tony Thomas

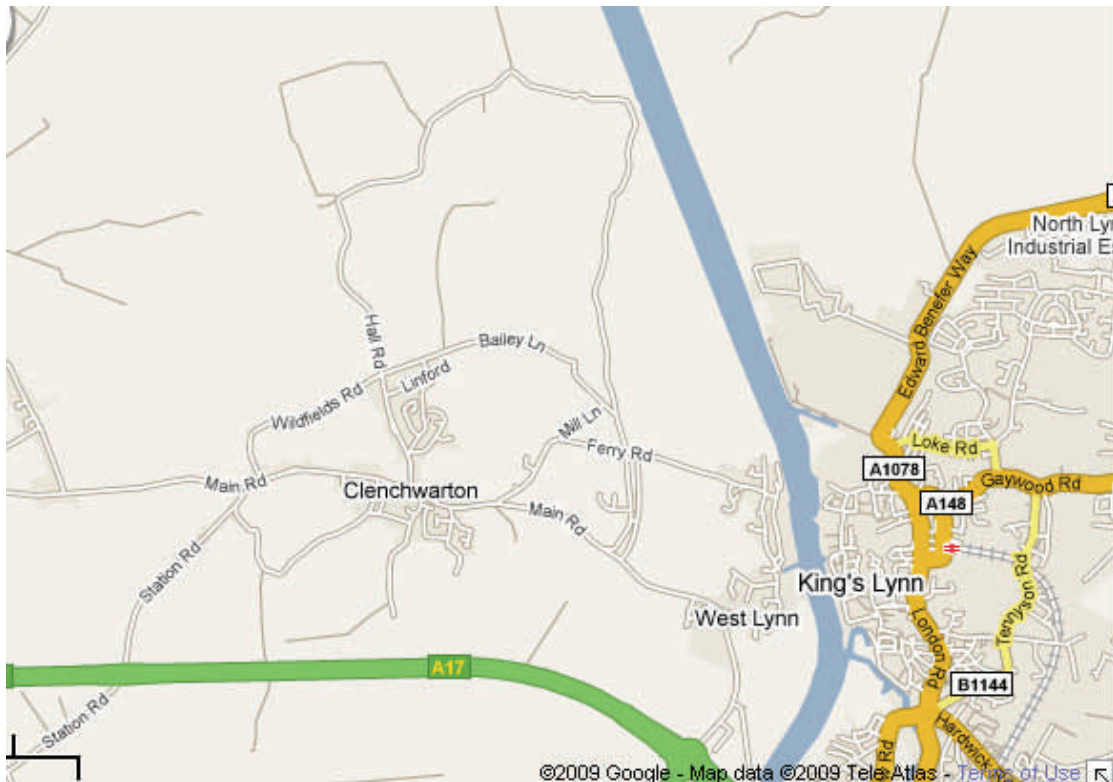
Committee member 1: Sam Attew Second by John Neave & Tony Thomas

Kings Lynn Venue Directions



Directions

With the addition of a new venue I thought it prudent to give everyone the directions so we can all enjoy a good match.

On the west bank, follow the road nearest the river, where it gets closest to the river there are 2 bends close together, we go through the gate at the 2nd bend (north) and park on the grass/meadow near the river.

Just before the first bend there is a sewage works. If you go over the river at Kings Lynn on the A47 take the 3rd exit on the roundabout to West Lynn/ Clenchwarton.

Go towards Clenchwarton and take the 3rd exit on the right just after some tall trees. The road is called Millennium Way and there also is a sign to Treatment Works. At the end of this road you hit Ferry Road, take a left and then immediate right which again is signposted to the Treatment Works.

Continue down this road until you see the gate on the 2nd bend. Please note there is no name to this road and it is a little way down there going past the new and then the old Treatment Works.

Club Growth

If possible all members should attend as this sort of event will benefit the club. I will also be printing Flyers for all members to take and distribute as they see fit.
